## MISSIONARY COOPERATION PLAN

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Next weekend, Rev. Dr. Bernard Okafor will be offering Mass with all of you and sharing news about a critical project in Nigeria. He will be here as part of the Missionary Cooperation Plan and speaking on behalf of the Congregation of The Holy Spirit, also known as the Spiritans. For over 300 years, their priests have served the spiritual and physical needs of poor people all over the world. One of their achievements is the establishment of the Holy Ghost Haven Foundation to address the urgent needs of the poor and to house and heal sick and infirmed Spiritan missionaries who have served so many in their lives.

The small compound in Mgbidi, Nigeria is locally referred to as "Holy Ghost Haven" and includes a small hospital and rest home where the elderly and missionary priests can be treated. The facilities desperately need to be repaired and expanded. It's emotionally heart rending because these missionaries have totally dedicated their lives to the cause of God, love and humanity, and are dependent on the generosity of others to house them in their time of need.

Fr. Bernard Okafor already knows that we don't have second collections here, at St. Peter's. However, we will be honored to give half of next weekend's offertory collection for this important cause.

If parishioners want to give additional, personal gifts which will be added to the 50% of our offertory collection, that would also be greatly appreciated. Make your check payable to St. Peter Church and write "missionary" on the memo line. Then simply place it in a regular envelope and mark it "Holy Ghost Haven." Drop it in the offertory basket along with your regular Sunday envelope.

In my absence, please let Fr. Bernard know how welcome he is in our community! Be sure to thank him for his priesthood and the privilege we have to help make Holy Ghost Haven better and bigger!

# (Practicing) Catholic Take More

It doesn't matter what time of day we visit my mother-in-law – she always has food to offer. If we take two helpings, she will encourage us to take three. If we take three helpings, she will say, "Coraggio – take more." (She's Italian, in case you couldn't tell from the food-pushing and the language).

When Jesus feeds the five thousand with the miracle of the loaves and fish, he does not produce *just* enough food to feed everyone who is there. He certainly could—that would be within His power. And He shows concern about waste, so it would make sense for Him to do that. But instead, He deliberately over produces. He creates more food than is necessary. He makes an abundance of it. Why?

I think it's for the same reason my mother-in-law keeps urging us to eat when we come to her house. Feeding people is not just a functional action. It's a gesture. It shows love. It shows concern. It shows welcome. Having an abundance of food—so much that there is some left over—is a sign that you don't care how much someone wants—you are ready to give whatever they are ready to take. You are ready to give recklessly. You are ready to give them not just all they need but also all they could want.

I think of this when I approach the sacrament of Confession. Time and time again I walk up to the door of that little room, a list of oft-repeated sins in my hand and a sense of shame on my heart.

Here I am again, Jesus. Back for more mercy. Hope you haven't run out.

He hasn't yet. He never will. "Coraggio," He whispers deep in my heart, "take more."
