

BIBLE QUOTES FOR WHEN YOU'RE AFRAID OF DEATH.

Around this time of year, with Halloween and All Souls' Day, thoughts naturally turn to themes of life and death. It's therefore common to feel a heightened awareness of mortality, and even fear of death. These reflections that will continue for the next several bulletins can stir anxiety about the unknown, but thankfully for Christians, the Bible offers profound comfort and reassurance.

The Catholic Faith teaches that death is not an end but a transition, a gateway to eternal life with God. And this teaching is reiterated throughout the Bible. If you look at these passages in particular, they can help calm fears about death, especially during this season, reminding us of the hope and peace found in Christ and the eternal life.

John 11:25-26 - Jesus told her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?'"

This passage is a reminder of Jesus' promise of eternal life. When facing the fear of death, it's comforting to remember that, through faith in Christ, death is not the end. Believers will continue to live in the presence of God. Jesus' words challenge us to trust in this truth, offering hope in the face of morality.
