

# Is It Too Much to ask Catholics to Attend Mass Every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation?

Let's do the math! Assuming that a person is in Mass for 1 hour every Sunday and holy day, that comes out to 58 hours spent in church every year. If there are 8,760 hours in a year, that means only 0.662% of your year will be spent praying the Mass! Compare that to the average American who spends 4.5 hours each day on their phone and 3 hours watching television.


So, if you truly believe that God the Father created the heavens and the earth and that He gave you the opportunity at life and love; if you believe that Jesus Christ died for your sins and offered you the chance of salvation through Him, then 58 hours per year in worship, prayer and communion with the Lord should be the absolute bare minimum that we can dedicate.

The Christmas season is about God revealing to us who and what and where He is. He has told us. The question is, have we listened?
